His alternative and innovative concepts in fashion design were intended to appeal to the intellectual consumer with his Groc fashion line still hugely popular overseas.

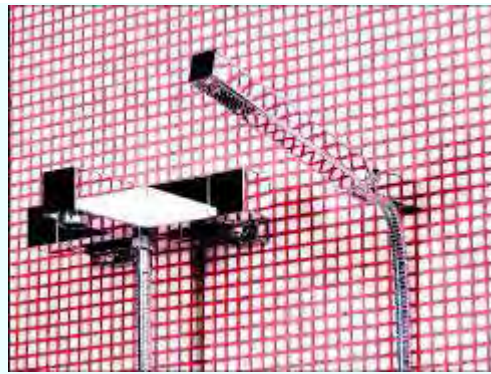
These concepts were then applied to his new path of bathware design.
