

Tapware gives bathrooms contemporary appeal

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Forget conventional tapware; interesting water spouts for baths and basins are the hot new must-haves for the stylish bathroom.

Bathroom products manufacturer Paco Jaanson has introduced an intriguing collection of water spouts, with equally interesting names, to the market.

“Designers such as Antonio Miro and Maurizio Duranti have lent their visions to create some superb designs,” a Paco Jaanson spokesman said.

The Love Me wall-mounted

bath spout with mixer (\$955, bottom right) provides a path for the water flow to fall in a stunning natural manner, while Only One (\$1290) — another wall-mounted spout but this time with a shelf — allows the water to flow through a thick cylinder.

There’s also the Antonio Miro bath set (\$568, above) a long, wall-mounted spout which produces a delicate ribbon of water, and the sharp-edged design of the Antonio Miro spa set (\$1726, above right).

“The flow of water can look

amazing with the right spout and there are myriad styles to create different looks and accentuate the theme of your bathroom,” the spokesman said.

“Wall-mounted spouts are particularly complementary to bathroom interiors and often become a sculptural feature in their own right.”
