Geels says people have seen so much colour in fashion, it was only a matter of time before it made an impact in the bathroom.

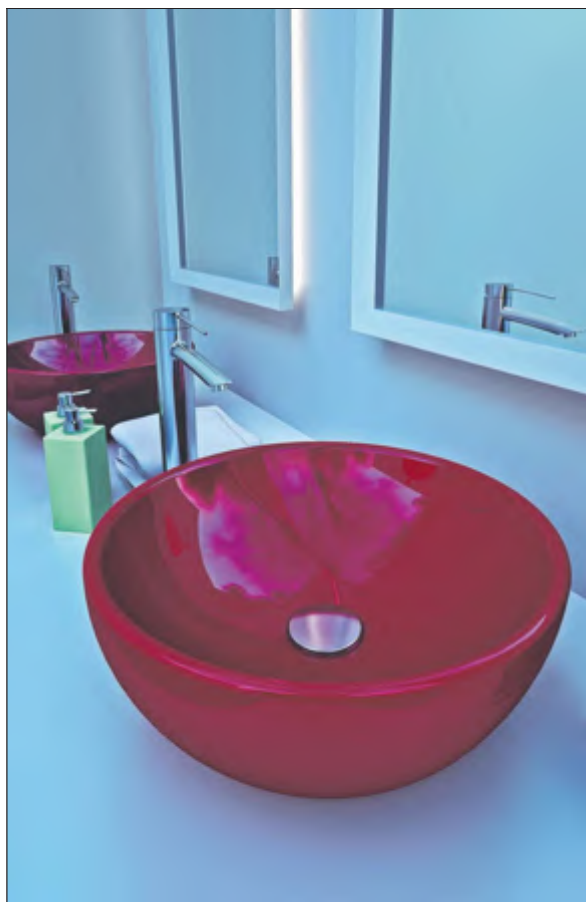
"We are seeing more and more Reece customers incorporating flashes of colour into their builds," she says.
